COMING AND GOING

For both Clarendon Park and New College, the FAMILY deliver the child to the door of the gymnastics hall. At the end of the lesson, any child who has **NOT YET STARTED their YEAR 7** schooling is required to be collected by the named parent, guardian or carer listed on their membership form. We will not allow these children to leave the building alone. Only where we have notice in writing that the collecting person is to be temporarily or permanently changed will we allow the child to leave with another person. For those who have started year 7 and above, parents and carers may opt to allow their child to leave alone as they do from their secondary school. New College has a front car park, an overflow car park to the side and a student's rear car park. There are many people from other activities sharing these car parks. We urge extra care and vigilance on darker evenings.
