During the next term we will be streamlining the method and technology that collects and manages our finances. You are NOT required to do anything, this is for information only. The changing technology provided through British Gymnastics will be seamless.

THE CHARITY is our foundation to ensure good delivery and legacy. **Hinckley Clarendon Sports and Community Association**. Registered Charity 1073220. The Charity can be found at the Charity Commission website.

Its purpose is to provide venues and opportunities for you to take part in activities which improve physical health, wellbeing and sport activities. Membership is by subscription.

VENUES

The Charity oversees the management of purpose build venues at Clarendon Park Hinckley and at The Herewoode Academy in Leicester both funded by us.

iFlip

The activities in the venues are delivered as a Not-For Profit organisation known as **iFlip** which can be found online together with all of our activities at: **iFlip.org**

The Trustees of the Charity and the Management Team of iFlip ensure that the aims of the Charity are protected and delivered fairly to all members of the community.

Joining us is by means of a SUBSCRIPTION from which the fabric of the buildings and delivery of the basic level of activities are provided and protected for generations to come.

There are no shareholders or individuals who receive financial gains or profit sharing from the Charity or the subscriptions. We have around 30 employees. The trustees are volunteers.

All staff and management are registered with British Gymnastics who are the National Governing Body of gymnastics in the UK. All activities are delivered by staff registered and approved by them. For ALL insurances and British Gymnastics memberships and competition entries we are known by our original name of Hinckley Gymnastics Club which has a proud 50 year history and respected reputation that we do not want to lose.

For the Charity, iFlip, both venues and Hinckley Gymnastics Club, all of their activities are compliant with statutory law.

JOINING IN

Membership of the organisation is by **monthly subscription**.

At its basic level of activity, classes of 1 hour or less, Disabilities and pre -chool, all of participant subscriptions go towards funding the venues, core staff and the program

For classes of more than one hour 25% of the subscription is directed into the sport pathway training and more specialist staff. The remainder supports the venues.

Where teams or squads are selected 50% of the subscription is directed into the sport pathway training and coaches of great knowledge and experience in competitive gymnastics at County, Regional and National/International level. The remainder supports the venues. All competitive entries are through Hinckley Gymnastics Club (HGC) who are the National Governing Body of Sport gymnastics in GB.

The Charity benefits from local fund raising, small grants for inclusive/special needs/exceptional programs. We also benefit from **GiftAid** agreed by members from their subscription.

GIFT AID

The Government scheme to support good causes from taxes paid. Part of your subscription is eligible for Gift Aid.

DECLARATION

By allowing us to treat a proportion of your subscription as a donation towards core costs, as listed above, Gift Aid tax relief can be claimed. We confirm that you have declared that you are a UK tax-payer and have given your consent via a Gift Aid declaration which is given to you when joining. If you have not already agreed to Gift Aid and would like to sign up, please contact us as we would welcome your help. It costs you nothing to sign up.

GIFT AID CONSENT

August 2026 I am a UK taxpayer and understand that if I pay less Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax in the current tax year than the amount of Gift Aid claimed on all my donations it is my responsibility to pay any difference.
